1	Acton Cemetery a.k.a. Old Acton Cemetery
	Travel I-65, Exit 246 in Pelham onto Ala. Hwy. 119 No. (Cahaba Valley Road). Turn left onto Caldwell Mill Road, right onto Pinto Lane and then right onto Palomino Trail. Cemetery is located in woods south of Blackhorse Bend just off Palomino Trail and in woods behind house located at 5459 Palomino Trail, Birmingham. Cemetery survey taken November 2013.
2	Allan Cemetery - Hwy 119 (a.k.a. Johnson Cemetery)
	Between Hwy. #31 and Hwy. #280 on Hwy. #119, in North Shelby County Alabama. Cemetery survey taken 2001.
3	Allen Cemetery - Near Sterrett
	About 5 miles North of Calcis, Go .1 mile NW of railroad tracks. Turn right off Hwy. #25 onto paved road. Cross railroad and immediately turn left onto another paved road. Follow this paved road until it ends. A dirt road Y's off the paved road that ends as a driveway. Pass a dirt road on the left and continue out the original road passed two dirt roads on the right. Turn left at intersection of two dirt roads (original road intersects as a "T". Follow this road to left until it intersects another road. Turn right atop the hill at this intersection. A left turn leads to Fire Rock, about 100 yards on left of the road. A right turn leads to Allen Cemetery. After right turn go about .2 mile to a road-like path off to the left, topping a hill. This is the cemetery. It is unwise to attempt to reach the cemetery without a jeep. The roads are grade A pigtrails.
4	Andrew Jackson Cross, Jr. Cemetery
	Located in the rear of the residence at 2300 Cahaba Valley Road. Cemetery survey taken August 2000.
5	Antioch Cemetery #2
	Hunnicutt.
6	Arkwright Baptist Cemetery
	Travel U.S. Hwy. 280 to Shelby County Hwy. 62 East (Harpersville). Travel approximately 3 miles to intersection of Hwy. #62 and # 85. Across from Arkwright Baptist Church. Cemetery survey taken September 2011. In August 2011 Bailey Cemetery was listed as a contributing resource in the Arkwright Heritage Area that was listed on the Alabama Register of Landmarks & Heritage.
7	Bailey Cemetery - Harpersville/Vincent/Arkwright Area
	Travel U.S. Hwy. 280 to Shelby County Hwy. 62 East (Harpersville). Travel approximately 3 miles to intersection of Hwy. #62 and # 85. Continue right on Hwy. 85 South. At the next intersection travel (left) onto Hwy. #62. Cemetery will be on the left through a gate, down a dirt road and in a pasture. Property is privately owned. Cemetery survey taken August 2011. In August 2011 Bailey Cemetery was listed as a contributing resource in the Arkwright Heritage Area that was listed on the Alabama Register of Landmarks & Heritage.
8	Bailey Cemetery - Skinner Hollow
	From I-65 take Exit #247 and travel Shelby County Hwy. 17 North (Valleydale Road) toward U.S. Hwy. 280. Turn right on Dogwood Circle (Shelby County Hwy. 369 North). The cemetery is on the left next to house located at 467 Dogwood Circle, Birmingham, AL 35244. Cemetery survey taken February 27, 2012. Placed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register in October 2011. "Bailey Cemetery, Circa 1840"
9	Baker Grove Cemetery (African-American)
	Travel U.S. Hwy. 280 to Shelby County Hwy. 62 East (Harpersville). Travel approximately 3 miles to intersection of Hwy. #62 and # 85. Continue right on Hwy. #85 South. Baker's Grove Baptist Church is on the right and cemetery is just past the church on the right, located on Baker Grove Lane. Placed on Alabama Historic Cemetery Register in December 2011. Cemetery survey taken September 2011.
10	Bay Springs Cemetery
	South of Columbiana on Hwy. #47, go 8 miles to Hwy. #311; turn right and go 1 mile. Cemetery on left.
11	Beaver Creek Baptist Cemetery a.k.a. Old Beaver Creek Cemetery a.k.a. Seale Cemetery
	Go .4 mile North of the Jct. of County Road #61 and #47 on Hwy. #47. Turn left on chert road (sign noting cemetery), Go .5 mile down chert road to "Y" and turn right, A sign marks road at "Y". The cemetery is .2 mile from "Y". Cemetery survey taken March 2009.
12	Benton Family Cemetery
	On Hwy. #119, just below Thompson Schools, at Siluria, Alabama (near creek). Cemetery survey taken June 2005. Listed on Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 22 June 2005.
13	Beulah Baptist Cemetery
	Located at Sterrett, Alabama.

14	Convict Cemetery - a.k.a. Prison Hill Cemetery in Aldrich
	from the prison that was located in Aldrich, Alabama were leased by the state to work in the coal mines in Aldrich. At death, if not claimed by their next of kin, they were buried in this cemetery. Cemetery survey taken 2004. Listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 13 September 2004.
15	Saginaw Cemetery (African-American Cemetery)
	Behind church at Intersection of U.S. Hwy. #31 and Shelby County Hwy. #340 East (Ozley Road) in Saginaw. Cemetery survey taken April 2005, about 50 unmarked graves at that time ... a.k.a Galilee Baptist Church Cemetery.
16	Black Cemetery in Vandiver
	Off Hwy. #45, approximately 100 yards past Union Hill Freewill Baptist Church. Atop a pine hill just East of the church cemetery.
17	Blackmon Cemetery
	About one mile West of Columbiana, Alabama at intersection of Hwy. #26 and #70. Cemetery survey taken September 2013. Listed on Alabama Historic Cemetery Register in October 2013.
18	Bold Springs Presbyterian Church Cemetery
	Bold Springs Presbyterian Church, established 1843. Travel U.S. Hwy. #280 West. Turn right on Alabama Hwy. #119 North. Church and Cemetery is on left, near Lake Purdy. Cemetery survey taken March 2005.
19	Boothe Cemetery
	Turn off Hwy. #10 West onto #251 North and go to the end of the pavement. Cemetery on left.
20	Brasher Cemetery - Brasherville Cemetery
	Brasherville, in Shelby County Alabama. Travel #47 South from Columbiana to Shelby, Alabama. Take County Road #303 to end of paved road. Cemetery is in pasture.
21	Brasher's Chapel Worship Center and Cemetery
	Travel U.S. Hwy. #280 West, turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #43 North. Travel 3.1 miles. Church and cemetery is on left. Cemetery survey taken April 2005. Church is now known as Abundant Grace.
22	Brasher Family Cemetery
	Cemetery is in woods, 2.6 miles SW of Jct. Hwy. #42 and #86, off Hwy. #86. Turn left off #86 on unpaved road. Follow road always going left with road, .6 mile to a secondary dirt road to the left. Turn up this road going uphill .1 mile to fenced-in cemetery.
23	Bryan Memorial Presbyterian Church Cemetery
	On Valleydale Road, across from entrance to Homestead Subdivision.
25	Cedar Grove Freewill Baptist Church Cemetery
	From Columbiana toward Wilsonville travel Alabama Hwy. #25 North to Shelby County Hwy. #5. Turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #5. Travel .5 mile and church and cemetery is on left. Cemetery survey taken March 2005.
26	Cedar Grove Cemetery, a.k.a. Meredith Cemetery
	About 2 miles North of Maylene, Alabama on Shelby County Hwy. #17. Cemetery survey taken 2002.
27	Chancellor Cemetery
	At Chancellor home, located at Jct. of Shelby County Hwy. #76 and Shelby County Hwy. #79.
28	Chapel Methodist Cemetery a.k.a. Old Chapel Methodist Church Cemetery
	On County Road #9, South of Wilsonville, Alabama. Cemetery survey taken October 2005.
29	Columbiana City Cemetery
	Hwy. #47 South, Columbiana, Alabama. Cemetery survey taken August 2006.
30	Connell, William Mack Family Cemetery
	Located off Alabama Hwy. #47 South, Beat #2 Shelby County Alabama. Going South on Hwy. #47 take dirt road left, after Hwy. #71 West. Then turn left onto logging road. Cemetery will be on the right.

	Turn south off Hwy. #70, .2 mile East of the Mile 2 Marker, go about 1/2 mile. There is an old log road which goes out on a ridge down to the cemetery, but it is blocked by a pile of dirt.
33	Captain William Cross Cemetery
	Located on Cahaba Valley Road at Indian Springs First Baptist Church. Cemetery survey taken July 2000.
34	Crumpton Cemetery
	From Columbiana travel East College Street to Shelby County Hwy. #28 East (right at forks). Travel approximately 4 miles to Shelby County Hwy. #77 North (left). Travel approximately 1 mile, turn right on Crumpton Cemetery Road (dirt road). Cemetery is located on right. Cemetery survey taken April 2005.
35	Dargin Cemetery
	Located at crossroads of US Hwy. #31, Ala. #70 East and Hwy. #22 West (between Calera and Alabaster). Cemetery survey taken April 2005.
36	Davis Falls Cemetery
	Located off a dirt extension of Shelby County Highway #206 near Almont. It is out a dirt road to left on top of a hill just past Mane Ranch Circle. Cemetery survey taken January 2002.
37	Deerhurst Cemetery
	From Alabaster travel Shelby County Hwy. #11 North for approximately 4.4 miles. Turn right on Bent Rail Lane and travel to end. Take the right paved drive beside the house. Cemetery is located on left behind the house. Cemetery survey taken June 2005.
38	Dover Cemetery
	From Columbiana travel Alabama Hwy. #25 South toward Calera. Turn left on Shelby County Hwy. #42 East. Travel approximately 2 miles (past the Calera water tank on left) to Brown Road on left. Cemetery is located on right approximately .1 mile on Brown Road. Cemetery survey taken 2004.
39	Dunnavant Community Cemetery
	From Vincent travel Alabama Hwy. #25 North to Dunnavant. Turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #41 North and travel .4 mile to Dunnavant Faith Baptist Church (Cemetery #1) and Mt. Olive Free Will Baptist Church (Cemetery #2). Cemetery is behind these two churches.
40	Old Dunnavant Cemetery (a.k.a. Lost Cemetery and/or Harmony Baptist Church Cemetery)
	Ridge Road (which quickly turns into a dirt road) and travel .5 mile to locked gate. To enter property please call Joe Isbell at (205) 369-9683. The cemetery is on the left approximately 1.5 miles past this gate. This is also referred to as the Harmony Baptist Church Cemetery , established in early 1800.
41	Ebenezer Cemetery
	From Hwy. #280 at Westover, Alabama travel North on Hwy. #55 for about 2 miles.
42	Elliottsville Cemetery
	On left side of Hwy #119, Siluria, Alabama, going toward Montevallo, next to Elliottsville Cumberland Presbyterian Church. This census includes (1) Elliottsville Cemetery, (2) Redmon Cemetery, (3) Still Memorial Cemetery, (4) Siluria Cotton Mill Cemetery, and (5) Negro Cemetery. These cemeteries are "all grouped together" and all are often referred to as "Elliottsville Cemetery." Cemetery survey taken November 1999.
43	Elliott Cemetery
	From Harpersville U.S. Hwy. 280 take U.S. Hwy. 231 North/Alabama Hwy. 25 North toward Vincent. Turn left onto Shelby County Hwy. 83 South (at Vincent High School) and travel about 1.5 miles. Cemetery is on the left in woods, down a dirt road. Cemetery survey taken September 2011.
44	Enon Baptist Church Cemetery
	Enon Baptist Church located at 4994 Shelby County Hwy. #18, Montevallo. Cemetery is across Hwy. #18 from the church. Cemetery survey taken June 2006 by Lyn Lucas.
45	Farr Family Cemetery
	From Wilsonville, Alabama travel South on Hwy. #25 to John Lyon's Hill (about 5 miles). Take dirt road to right and go to and to unpainted house. A small dirt road on side of house leads through pasture and woods to cemetery. Cemetery is clean and surrounded by chain link fence. It is between Wilsonville and Jackson Springs (Co. Road #55); about 1/2 mile North of Hwy. #25.

	From Columbiana travel Shelby County Hwy. #47 North. Turn left on Lakewood Lane. Cemetery is on the right.
48	Fourmile Baptist Cemetery
	From Columbiana toward Wilsonville travel Alabama Hwy. #25 East to Shelby County Hwy. #55 North. Turn left on Shelby County Hwy. #55 North. Turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #61 South. Church and Cemetery is located on right. Cemetery survey taken in September 2007.
50	Glover Cemetery
	On property owned by Rowe family. Contact Marvin Rowe on County Road #60, 1 mile East of #231 (in green house to right), Near Vincent, Alabama off Hwy. #60 leading to Coosa River. Cemetery is off Glover Ferry Road which leads to Glover Landing on the Coosa River.
51	Good Hope Methodist Cemetery
	Good Hope Methodist Church). Travel .9 mile, turn right down dirt road (Frontier Acres), cemetery in woods on right. Cemetery survey taken June 2005.
52	Harkins Cemetery
	Traveling from Alabaster toward Calera on U.S. Hwy. #31, turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #22 West. Travel to Shelby County Hwy. #12 West (Airport Road), turn right. Turn left onto Merlin Drive. Cemetery is located behind house located at 791 Merlin Drive, Calera. Cemetery has rock fence in the shape of a building. Cemetery was located on Guy Youngblood's property.
53	Harless Cemetery (a.k.a. Ebenezer, Old Ebenezer and Harless-Wyatt Cemetery)
	From Alabaster on U.S. Hwy. #31 South, turn right onto Ala. Hwy. #119 South (toward Montevallo). Turn left onto County Hwy. #24 East. Cemetery is on the left between Ala. Hwy. #119 and County Hwy. #12 (past Ebenezer Church). Cemetery survey taken February 2009. Cemetery was listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register in March 2009.
54	Harpersville Cemetery (a.k.a. Garden of Memories)
	2006.
55	Harris Cemetery
	Harris Cemetery, established 1852. Travel U.S. Hwy. #280 West, turn right on Alabama Hwy. #119 North. Cemetery is on side of road (chain link fence) after Calvmet Meadows subdivision and before the John Deere Landscape (7347 Cahaba Valley Road). Cemetery survey taken March 2005.
56	Heaton Cemetery (a.k.a. Ticer Cemetery)
	From Wilsonville, Alabama travel to intersection of Shelby County Hwy. #61 South and Hwy. #25, turn onto Shelby County Hwy. #61 South and travel for about 3.4 miles thus crossing Shelby County Hwy. #30. After crossing Shelby County Hwy. #30 go to 6045 Hwy. 61 (Wilsonville). Cemetery is located on privately owned property on the right and is badly over-grown. Cemetery survey taken September 2012.
57	Helena Cemetery a.k.a. Harmony Graveyard
	Behind Presbyterian Church on Hwy #17/251 in Helena, Alabama. Cemetery survey taken August 2002. In December 2010 Harmony Graveyard, commonly referred to as the Helena City Cemetery, and Harmony Cemetery, an African-American burying ground located adjacent to Harmony Graveyard, were both favorably reviewed and listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register with the Alabama Historical Commission.
58	Higginbotham Cemetery
	On hill behind Burgess Whispering Pines Ranch pasture on Bibb County Road #13. The Bibb and Shelby counties line divides the cemetery.
60	Holley Cemetery
	From Harpersville, Alabama travel about 3 miles South on Alabama Highway #76 between mile markers 1 & 2. In middle of cotton field across highway from first paved road to left. A black cemetery.
61	Hollis Cemetery
	From U.S. Hwy. #280 turn onto Shelby County Hwy. #43 North. Travel 10.3 miles, cemetery is on left across from "JCT Shelby County Hwy. #491" sign. Also, sign on left in cemetery area reads "The Meadows". Cemetery survey taken August 22, 2006.

62	Howard Cemetery
	To get to this remote cemetery, go to the small community between Davis Chapel F. W. Baptist Church and Lawley's Chapel Cemetery on County Hwy. #55 to about .2 mile from Shelby and St. Clair Counties line. Turn on a dirt road at Mr. Alver Partridge's home. You should stop at his home and inquire. The cemetery is almost exactly one mile South of Highway #55 on the dirt road. This road is privately owned, with gates near Mr. Partridge's home, but it used to be the main road before Hwy. #55 was cut. All the houses along the road are now gone. Follow the road .9 mile from Hwy. #55 to a "Y" and take the the left fork for about .1 mile. The fenced cemetery is atop a hill on left road.
63	Hubbard Cemetery, a.k.a. Tinney Cemetery
	From Chelsea, go South on Hwy. #47 about 5 miles; 1/4 mile South of intersection of #333 and #47.
64	Johnson Cemetery
	From Columbiana travel Alabama Hwy. #25 North to Shelby County Hwy. #5. Turn right on Shelby County Hwy. #5. Less than 1 mile, cemetery is on right. Cemetery survey taken April 2005.
65	Jones Cemetery, a.k.a. Garrett Cemetery
	From Alabaster travel U.S. Hwy. #31 South, turn left onto Shelby County Hwy. #26 East (toward Columbiana). Turn left onto Shelby County Hwy. #339 North and then turn left onto Camp Branch Raod (in front of Camp Branch Methodist Church). Turn right onto Camp Branch Circle (a dirt road). At the top of the first hill (about one block) turn right into a trailer park (1425 Camp Branch Circle). Cemetery is behind the first trailer on the left inside a wooden fenced in area. Many unmarked graves. Cemetery is approximately .5 acre. Cemetery survey taken April 2009.
66	Jones-Bailey Cemetery
	Four miles North of Calera on U.S. Hwy. #31, on left going toward Alabaster. Cemetery survey taken August 2004. Listed on the Alabama Landmarks & Heritage on 13 November 1978. Listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 08 October 2004.
67	Kidd Cemetery
	Located on Hwy. #25, across from Harpersville Cemetery.
68	King Cemetery
	On campus of the University of Montevallo in Montevallo, Alabama.
69	K-Springs Cemetery
	Highway #39 at Chelsea, Alabama. Cemetery survey taken 2002.
70	Kirkland Cemetery
	Located in the "Piney Woods" three miles north of Wilsonville. Go 3 miles north on County Road #61, turn right on dirt road in curve of road. Go approximately 1/2 mile to dirt crossroads, Turn right, go 4 miles to logging road off to right going up hill, about 150 yards. Property owned by Gulf States Paper Co. All graves are marked by rocks.
71	Langley Family Cemetery
	Travel #41 North at Dunnavant. 2½ to 3 miles at Alexander Road. In a field to the South of the road at a small grove of trees.
72	Lawleys Chapel Cemetery
	Located off County Highway #55 at the Shelby and St. Clair Counties line.
73	Leach Cemetery
	Located 3 1/2 miles East of Calera off of Highway #25 (Columbiana Road.) Turn right at Leach Cemetery Road, cross railroad track, proceed .5 mile, turn right to cemetery on top of a hill. Sign marks the turn.
74	Liberty Baptist Cemetery
	Located on Shelby County Highway #47 South, at intersection of #439, about 1 mile South of Chelsea, Alabama.
75	Lindsay Cemetery
	Located on Hwy. #17, between Helena and Maylene, near Brantleyville.
76	Linhholm Cemetery
	On County Road #10 to Jct. of #54 at Pea Ridge near Mayberry Creek. (The cemetery is on property of Paul E. CRENSHAW.)

	Cemetery is located on Highway #231 near St. Clair Co. line, 4 mi. North of Vincent, Alabama.
79	Macedonia Church Cemetery - Near Dogwood
	On Hwy. #22, 4 miles West of Dogwood, Alabama.
80	Masters Cemetery
	Go .2 miles west of Co. Rd #463 on Highway #62 going toward U.S. Hwy. #280/#231. The cemetery is on the left inside a pasture fence.
81	May Plantation Cemetery
	Near Shelby, Alabama, about 1/4 mile off County Rd. #86 South of County Hwy. #42.
82	McDaniel Cemetery
	Travel U.S. Hwy. #280 West. Turn left on Alabama Hwy. #119 South and travel approximately 1.6 mile to Katy Circle (The Cedars subdivision) on right. Cemetery is located on left (approximately 11 yards off Alabama Hwy. #119) exactly .1 mile from Katy Circle on right and before you get to Woodland Circle (Woodland subdivision) on right. Cemetery is on property owned by family at 6321 Cahaba Valley Road (on left, across from Katy Circle). There are several graves marked with stones; however, only one grave with marker. Cemetery survey taken March 2005.
84	Montevallo Cemetery
	On County Road #73 in Montevallo, Alabama.
85	Moore's Cemetery - a.k.a. Moore's Crossroads Cemetery
	Located on Alabama Hwy. #119, next to Crossroads Baptist Church, near intersection of Alabama Hwy. #119 and Shelby County Hwy. #22.
86	Mose Davis Cemetery
	From Columbiana travel Shelby County Hwy. #47 North. Turn left on Lakewood Lane and go past Foster Cemetery. At end of paved road (approximately .2 mile) travel dirt road. Take right at fork on dirt road. Cemetery is on the right in the woods 1 mile from paved road.
87	Mt. Era Cemetery
	Between Saginaw and Columbiana on Shelby County Hwy. #26, across from Mt. Era United Methodist Church. Cemetery survey taken July 2004.
88	Mt. Calvary Baptist Church Cemetery
	Mt. Calvary Baptist Church registered on Alabama Register of Landmarks and Heritage on 16 April 1985. From Columbiana toward Chelsea travel Shelby County Hwy. #47 North. Turn left on Shelby County Hwy. #69 North. Turn left on Shelby County Hwy. #74 West. Church is located approximately 1.5 mile on left and cemetery across highway on right (before Jct. Shelby County Hwy. #39). In the same building, Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church was founded 09 April 1856. Listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 31 August 2010.
89	Mt. Chapel Cemetery
	This cemetery is located in a pasture. Access is from a dirt road that turns off County Hwy. #39. At one time, there was a church or school here.
91	Mt. Signal Baptist Cemetery
	On Old Highway #280, across highway from the church. Travel 1/4 mile past County Road #440 East.
92	Mt. Tabor Methodist Church Cemetery
	From Chelsea travel U.S. Hwy. #280 East to Shelby County Hwy. #280 East (a.k.a. Old Hwy. #280). Turn left, travel 5.2 miles. Cemetery and church is located on right, between intersection of Shelby County Hwy. #51 and Shelby County Hwy. #55. Located at Westover, Alabama. Cemetery survey taken August 2004. Listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 26 August 2004.
93	Nabors Cemetery
	Turn off US Hwy #31 So., on to Shelby County Hwy. #26, go 4/10 miles. Turn right on Mellow Drive, go .1 mile. Cemetery is on left. Cemetery survey taken 2002. Listed on the Alabama Historic Cemetery Register on 12 August 2004.
